### Topic: Conjunctions

**A conjunction joins words or a group of words of the same type.**

- **And** expresses addition.



**Jake and Anna**

(Noun Conjunction Noun)

Two nouns- the names of people- are joined by the conjunction **and**, making it possible to form a sentence such as **Anna and Jake are friends.**

- **Or** expresses a choice:

**Maria or Anna**

(Noun Conjunction Noun)

Two nouns are joined by the conjunction **or**, indicating a choice in a question such as **Can Maria *or* Anna come over?**

- **Conjunctions can be used to join adjectives as well.**

**Hot or cold?**

(**adjective conjunction adjective**)



**How do you like your steak? Medium or rare?**
